16th Annual Piedmont USBC Youth Championship Tournament Rules

1.This tournament is certified through the United States Bowling Congress (USBC). Rules not covered in this form are governed by US8C rules and regulations.

2.Participants must hold a current USBC membership card and be a member of a certified league competing in the Piedmont USBC Association or an association within a reasonable (i.e., approximately 1 hour) commute from the Piedmont Association. Youth bowlers from Greensboro, Burlington-Alamance, Statesville, High Point, and Mooresville Associations are welcome to participate. The Tournament Director reserves the right to accept or decline any entry from any Association not listed in this Rule.

3.Averages: It is the responsibility of the bowler to verify proper averages and to verify that proper documentation is submitted.

Averages will be used as follows:

a. Highest 2024-25 Piedmont USBC book average.

b. Highest current Piedmont USBC league average as of April 1, 2026, with a minimum of 12 games. Proof of the average must be provided with a league standing sheet.

c. Bowlers who do not meet the criteria above will enter with a 220 average. Rerates: USBC Rule 319c applies.

4.Entry deadline is May 10, 2026.

5.The tournament is divided into four (4) divisions by average.

| Events/Division | I | II | III | IV |
|-----------------|---------------|---------|---------|---------------|
| Singles | 181 and above | 141-180 | 101-140 | 100 and below |
| Doubles | 361 and above | 281-360 | 201-280 | 200 and below |

6. The handicap will be 90% of difference between the bowler's average and 220.

7. Teams will consist of 2 bowlers; they may be all males, all females, or mixed. Single bowlers must enter Doubles and vice versa. Multiple entries are not allowed. The tournament director reserves the right to modify the tournament format at their discretion.

8. AWARDS: Scholarship awards will be awarded from each event per division. The amount awarded will be based on the number of entries received and at the discretion of the Tournament Director. The example below is based off of 38 entries. In case of a tie for the championship in any event, USBC Playing Rules 118b-3 will be applied.

9. Entry fee Breakdown: Entry fee is \$50.00; Lineage, \$18.00 Prize Fund, \$32.00

10. Check-In for Your Event: Team Captains and/or bowlers should check-in 30 minutes before the event. We will start early if all the bowlers are present.

11. Substitutions: All substitutions must be made before the event. There will be no change in the line-up at the time of BOWLING. If a BOWLER is not present at his/her time to bowl, they will receive "0" pins for the frame. Absent bowlers will receive 0-pins for each frame missed.

12. Electronic Devices: No electronic devices may be used during competition. Bowlers are expected to participate in acceptable bowling attire and may be disqualified if not.
